Lawn Bowling Green Reservations

The bowling greens at Lake Park in Milwaukee, WI are home to the Milwaukee Lake Park Lawn Bowling Association. We welcome groups of family, friends, and business associates to learn the game of lawn bowls. Our club provides all the necessary equipment and our

members provide instruction.

Games are geared towards mixing and mingling. They are great fun for meeting new people, team-building, celebrating life events, or hanging out in a unique way. Consider spending an afternoon with us this summer for your next group event.

Reservations are for 2 hours and the greens are available on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday in the late afternoon. Groups of up to 40 can be accommodated.

The only equipment you need to bring - flat soled shoes to wear on the greens

There are picnic tables for pre and post game socializing. You can provide your own picnic or have your event catered. (Lake Park Bistro is next door and has catered past events, including bar setup under the pavilion porch with waiters delivering appetizers to the greens.)

Your event begins with selecting lawn bowls, which are available in sizes for large, medium, or small hands. Then there will be an explanation of the basic rules - how to deliver the bowl, order of play, and counting the "shots" or points. Next is practice with a couple of "trial ends" to get a feel for the "weight" and "bias" of the bowls. Then the games begin! If playing a tournament format, teams are decided, short games played, and everyone moves to the next opponent at the same time. If playing a social format, there is more flexibility with people coming and going. An even number of players and teams is preferred, but odd numbers can be accomodated.

The bowling greens are meticulously maintained and we need your cooperation to keep them in playing condition. Lawn bowls are never lofted or tossed. They are always rolled. Shoes with heels damage the playing surface, so flat soled shoes or barefoot are your footwear options.

Green fees are:

\$200 (group size up to 20)

\$300 (group size 21-30)

\$400 (group size 31-40)

Green fees reserve the greens for 2 hours and includes equipment and instruction by our club members. A signed contract and deposit of \$100 is required to reserve the green for your event. The balance is due one week prior to the event. We accept payment by check and credit card.

Weather is the one thing we cannot control. Rain-outs will be refunded or rebooked if available.
